This tutorial will explain how to utilize **Zoom** with the existing classroom technology for virtual and hybrid sessions during fall 2020



#### What's in the classroom

- Touchscreen Control Unit
- Room PC
- Display(s)
  - Projector
  - Flat Screen TV
- Document Camera
- Optional Laptop Cables



#### Before class

- Go to your Canvas course and set up a Zoom meeting for your upcoming class

- Plan to bring a USB Webcam if you would like your virtual students to see you during class
  - This is optional; you may elect to only broadcast your voice/computer screen
- Classroom technology training is available in person, by appointment

  - Turn on the technology
  - Connect your optional webcam
  - Log in to Canvas
  - Load your lecture materials on the PC




#### Laptops

#### Select Computer Sources






## Select Rack Computer

#### PC will automatically set up most webcams




#### Select Zoom from the sidebar menu\*



## Start your Zoom meeting




## Click Open Zoom Meetings if prompted

#### Test Speaker and Microphone, then Join with Computer Audio








